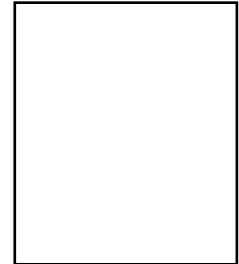

TOURIST VISA

- The tourist visa must be used within sixty days from the date it has been issued, and it is valid for one or two entries and a staying period in the country up to thirty days, renewable only once for equal period of time

- The Government can establish and make corrections, unilaterally or by agreement, of a list of countries whose citizens are exonerated from the obligation of having entry visas to stay in the country for a period less than ninety days.

- The tourist visa does not allow its bearer to stay permanently in the national territory, nor the exercise of any remunerated activity.

TRANSIT VISA

- The transit visa must be used within sixty days from the date it has been issued, it allows its bearer to stay in the country up to five days, it is valid for one or two entries and it is not renewable.

- The transit visa can be exceptionally granted at the border post to a foreign citizen who, in a continuous journey is forced to interrupt it to make a compulsory stop-over by the means of transport utilized.

SHORT DURATION VISA

- The short duration visa must be used within 72 hours, it allows the foreign citizen to stay in the national territory up to seven days and is renewable for an equal period of time.

The concession of a short duration visa does not require prior authorization by the Foreign and Migration Services, being enough to communicate its emission.

The short duration visa does not allow its bearer to reside permanently in the national territory, nor the exercise of any remunerated activity.

ORDINARY VISA

- The ordinary visa must be used within sixty days from the date it has been issued and allows its bearer to stay up to thirty days, and can be renewed twice for an equal period of time.

The ordinary visa does not allow the bearer to reside permanently in the national territory, nor the exercise of any remunerated activity.
